

Papros Inc supports data collection from suppliers or others on its platform.

People should be also be aware that there are third party data collection systems through Box and Dropbox that are quite easy to use, scale well and relatively inexpensive-these come with full data history and other metrics and make it easy for people to collect data. Papros Inc systems interface quite well with these two commercially available solutions that use “File Request” to get data to a single link. Both Box and Dropbox have their own merits, Box has on-premises feature and has substantial enterprise buy-in and Dropbox is making inroads into the enterprise.

For Dropbox, after you have authorized for Dropbox:

For the desktop features of MRPRO™, just sync your Dropbox data collection folder with a folder within c:\mrp51 on the desktop.

For the hybrid cloud features:

If you have appropriate license, the Papros site can let you :

1. Set a persona, follow the link, a persona has to be eight characters at a minimum.
2. Set a remote folder in Dropbox for the receiving folder. First create the folder on Dropbox, then come to the Papros site and enter the remote folder following the links and the example.
3. Receive any type of file from those you give your “persona” address to. You can change your “persona” once you decide on ending the cycle and beginning a different cycle. Data received is identified by submitter's account at Papros Inc. The data will come into your remote folder.
4. You will be able to perform all kinds of Masterlist and BOM scrubs based on the type of data.

For Box, just sync your folders with a folder within c:\mrp51 on the desktop.
